SOWING THE SEEDS OF PEACE.

ZECHARIAH 8:12

We live in an era of uncertainty - of weather events, aggression through war, gun violence, human trafficking, international conflict, employment, inflation, illness — the list goes on. However, humanity always has, in one form or another.

Long ago, the Psalmist wrote: "Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me" (Psalm 23:4, NRSV). We claim God's promise — you are with me.

With this promise in mind, we participate in the Peace & Global Witness Offering as Presbyterians draw together to provide support to brothers and sisters in Christ who work for peace every day. It helps encourage our church partners in Ukraine as they struggle against the trauma of war. It helps congregations begin to address the growing mental health crisis and the increase in the number of suicides in their communities. It provides resources for congregations seeking to address issues of gun violence in their communities.

We give because we know that every level of society needs Christ's peace. 25% of this Offering stays with our congregation to support peacemaking and reconciliation; 25% is retained by mid councils to support peacemaking efforts with our neighboring congregations; and the remaining 50% is used by the Presbyterian Mission Agency to join the peacemaking efforts of church partners all over the globe. We join these monetary gifts with our prayers for peace and our work for justice. In recent years, our church's portion was dedicated to supporting our mission co-workers Mark Hare and Jenny Bent in Costa Rica.


