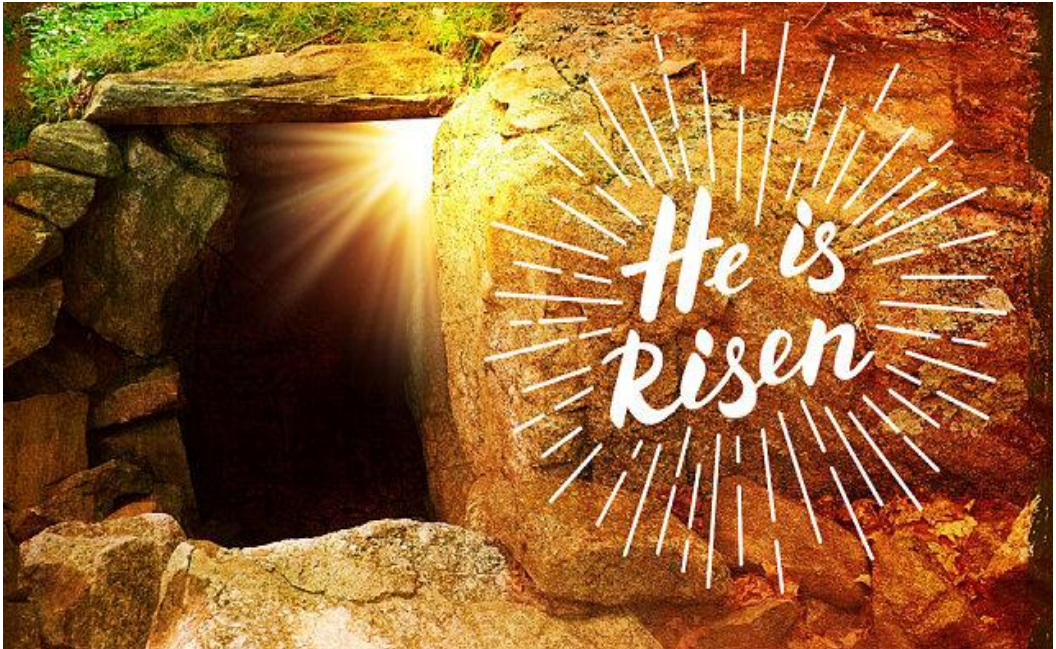

THE PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING

We remember the life and ministry of Jesus: how he healed the sick, fed the hungry, ate with sinners, and preached forgiveness and peace. It was at this table that he issued the invitation: to gather together, to share together, to remember together, and to go and do likewise in the world.

THE WORDS OF INSTITUTION

We remember with thanksgiving our Lord's Supper, shared with his closest of friends, in which he took the bread and blessed it, broke it, and gave it to them, saying: This is my body. Take and eat it, remembering me.

We remember how he took a cup, saying: This cup is the new covenant sealed in my blood, shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. Drink it, all of you, in

remembering me.

And so, on this day of resurrection, we raise our voices to proclaim this timeless truth:

Christ has died. Christ is risen! Christ will come again!

Pour out your Holy Spirit on us, your people, and on these gifts of bread and wine.

Make us lovers and tellers of your word. Make us healers and bestowers of your

grace. And make us one body in Jesus Christ, to the glory of your sacred name.

Amen.

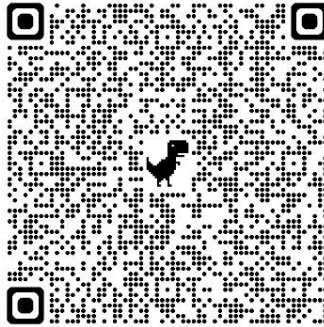

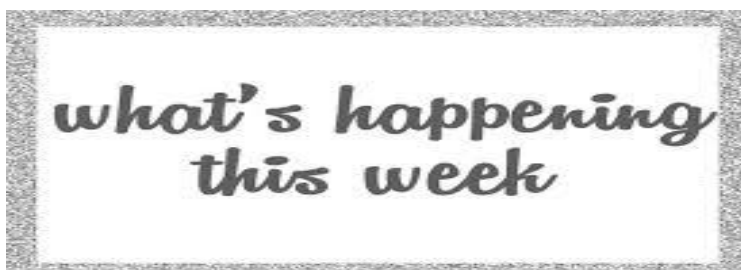
