

THE HEAT IS ON!



It's summertime and that means it's going to be hot, hot, hot!

Last year to save on the wear and tear on our "old, on-borrowed-time" sanctuary air conditioning system, we worshipped in the FLC during the summer months.

This summer we have new tenants (Pentecostal Church of God) who are renting our sanctuary for their weekly worship services from noon to 3:00 pm (when unfortunately the temperature will be even hotter). So, as the landlord, we need to ensure that the sanctuary is comfortable enough for them to worship there without forcing them to worship in the FLC.

Currently, through many of the recent successful fundraising events supported by our church, the revenue generating committee has \$7,500.00 available towards the purchase of a new sanctuary air conditioning system. Also, the church has received 2 donations totaling \$1,500.00 designated toward this capital improvement for a starting total of \$9,000.00, while the projected cost for a new system is between \$30,000.00 to \$35,000.00.

In addition to your regular offerings that are used to pay for the church's current expenses, we are prayerfully requesting if you can financially support additional donations toward the purchase of this new system.

If you can, please memo your check, e-donation, or regular pew envelope, "A/C System," so that our financial secretary can designate these donations toward the purchase of this new system.

BLUE CLAWS BALL GAME


Ready for a night of fastballs, fun, and fellowship?
