Dear Friends,

Three things for your consideration as we enter November. (By the way, have you ever noticed how ministers always seem to have three things to say, three points to a sermon, and three things to list within

parentheses? Blame it on the power of Trinitarian Theology!)

- 1 I hope you will join me, wherever you are, in celebration and gratitude on Wednesday, November 5! And what are we celebrating and grateful for? It is the day after Election Day and we won't have to watch anymore of those political commercials on TV! In our Presbyterian/Reformed Tradition we are urged to participate in the political process, to vote our faith in those issues that echo the priorities of Christ. However, I don't think that even the old French lawyer, John Calvin, who outlined the scope and focus of our faith, would have wanted us to waste our time and energy watching political commercials!
- 2 I hope you will join me, wherever you are, in celebration and gratitude on Thursday, November 27, our National Day of Thanksgiving. This is also one of the pillars of our particular corner of the Theological world. From the Biblical model of a harvest holiday to our American experience of Food, Family and Football (see, another triple play) it is important to measure the ways that God has blessed us over the year gone by and to recommit ourselves to being a People of Hope.
- 3 And speaking of Hope, that will bring us to the First Sunday in Advent and the lighting of the Candle of Hope on Sunday, November 30 to start the season. I am deeply grateful that you are allowing me to lead worship through the four Sundays of Advent and Christmas Eve this year. My guiding perspective, throughout all of my Advent/Christmas seasons as a pastor, has been that this holy time together is the only Advent/Christmas that matters, because it is the only one that we can do anything about. There has never been, nor will there ever be again, an Advent/Christmas of 2025. There has never been, nor will there ever be again, a time when we, and those whom we love, have been this age; when our health and our faith has been, or will be, what it is this year; when our world and our nation and our Church has been, or will be, exactly like they are right now. If we miss it, we can never recapture the blessings that God has in store for us this year. I hope that you all will make a special effort to be in worship those four Sundays and that one Wednesday night, not because I will be there, that is a trivial thing, but because God will be there. That is the promise above all of the other promises: Emmanuel, God-With-us.

Please consider donating to beautify our church for Christmas. Thank you.


DECORATING FOR ADVENT


