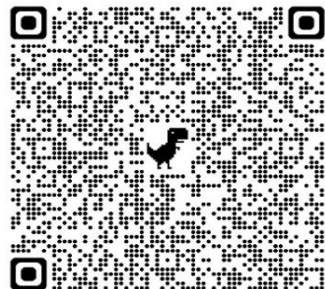


Call for the Annual Meeting of the Congregation and Corporation

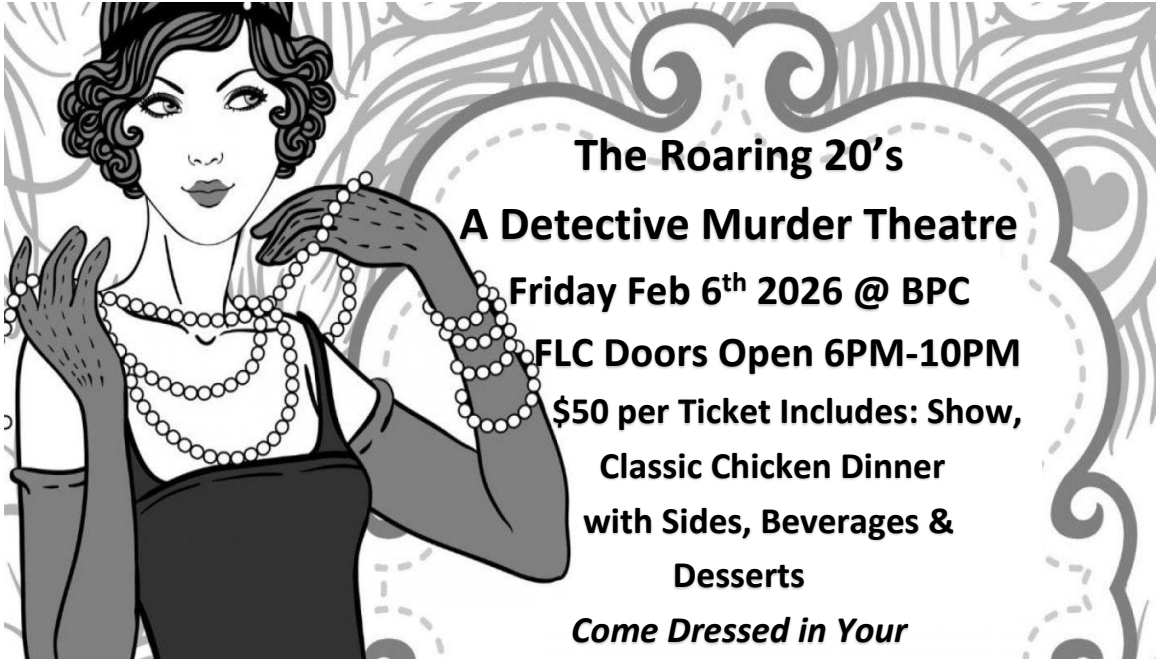
